Movement of ready-to-cook whole birds was light to moderate at best with overall activity noted as typically lighter and about normal for mid-week. Offerings varied by both volume and size; however 3.0 pound and heavier sizes were generally noted as at least adequate and lighter weights in good balance to closely cleared. Live supplies were mostly moderate; weights were mixed in a full range of light to heavy. Processing schedules were moderate to moderately heavy. Less than trucklot asking prices

were unchanged at 57 to 71 cents. Trade sentiment was mostly steady. In the parts complex, wings again dominated buyer interest.

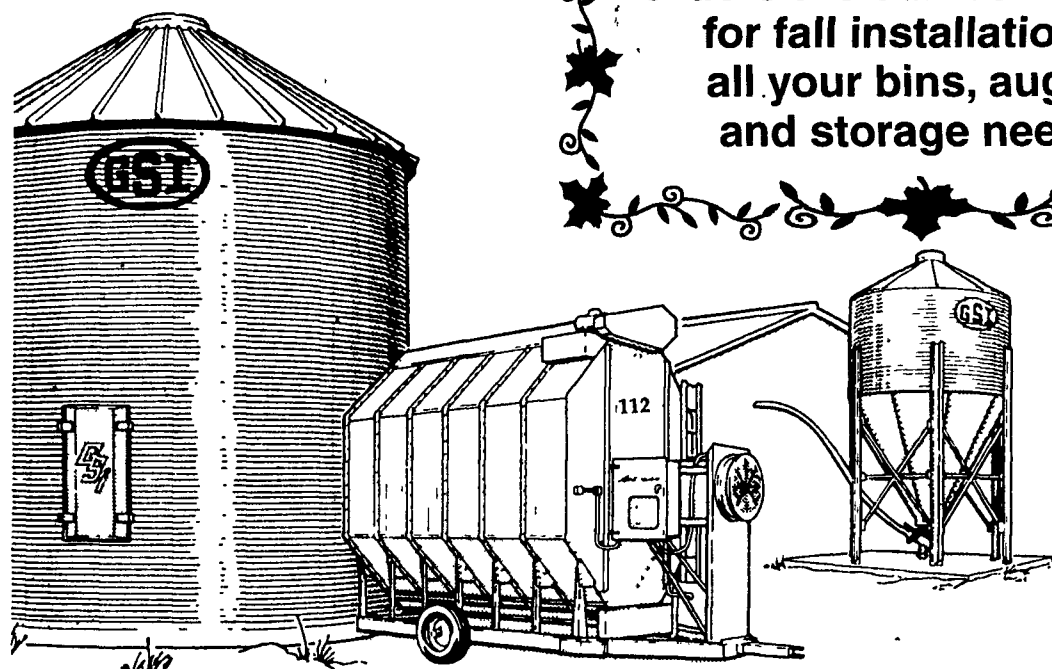
