Grain and soybean bids gathered some strength after yesterday's declines. Light overnight export sales offered a little support but trade corrections and fund buying were main plus factors. Otherwise, trading was quiet as traders wait to see how weekly export turn out and what the next production reports will show. Good growing weather continued to limit advances.

Wheat 2 to 5 cents higher. Corn 2 to 4 cents higher. Sorghum 4 cents higher. Soybeans mostly 1 to 7 cents higher with some 3 cents lower in Central Illinois.
