Northampton County 4-H Roundup Posts Goat, Sheep Results

MOORESTOWN (Northampton Co.) - Ken Brubaker, Womelsdorf, breeder of commercial sheep and coach of the Berks County 4-H judging team, reviewed the entries of the market goat and market sheep shows at the Northampton County 4-H Community Roundup recently.

Brubaker selected Amber Buttner as the junior fitter of the market goat portion of the roundup. Buttner went on to become the champion fitter with senior fitter, Diana Holder, being named the reserve champion fit-

In the showmanship competition, Buttner and Holder switched places with senior Holder being named champion showman and junior showman Buttner receiving the reserve showman honors. Buttner was also named the champion fitter and champion showman of the dairy goat fitting and showmanship competition of the roundup.

Reserve champion fitter of the dairy goat show was Jamie Osborn with Derick Stenlake being selected as the reserve champion showman.

In the weight classes Buttner's 80-pound entry from the heavyweight class was selected as the champion market goat. Julie Blackadar's 62-pound winner of the medium weight class went on to be named reserve champion of the market goat show.

In the sheep competition of the roundup, James Ford, the first place winner of the senior fitting competition, went on to be named the champion fitter. Buttner then took reserve fitter honors.

Brubaker selected Julie Blackadar as his champion showman from the senior division with Diana Holder receiving the reserve champion showman title.

Ford's 108-pound winner of the medium weight class went on to be named the grand champion market lamb with Holder's

107-pound second place entry from the same medium weight class taking reserve champion market lamb honors.


