**NATIONAL BOXED BEEF:** Boxed beef lower on moderate demand and moderate to heavy offerings. Select cuts steady to weak. Choice chuck and round cuts weak while rib and loin cuts lower. Beef trimmings generally steady on light to moderate demand and moderate offerings.

Estimated composite cutout value of Choice 1-3 600-750 lbs carcasses dn 1.02 at 113.91, 750-900 lbs dn 1.12 at 111.77; Select 1-3 600-750 lbs dn .43 at 101.94, 750-900 lbs dn .86 at 100.95; based on 193.86 loads of Choice cuts, 188.13 loads of Select cuts, 56.42 loads of Trimmings, and 72 787 loads of coarse ground trimmings.

Carcass Price Equivalent Index Value: Choice 1-3 600-750 lbs dn .56 at 104.78, 750-900 lbs dn .63 at 103.27; Select 1-3 600-750 lbs dn .26 at 93.53, 750-900 lbs dn .56 at 92.85. Current index reflects the equivalent of 385,322 head of cattle.

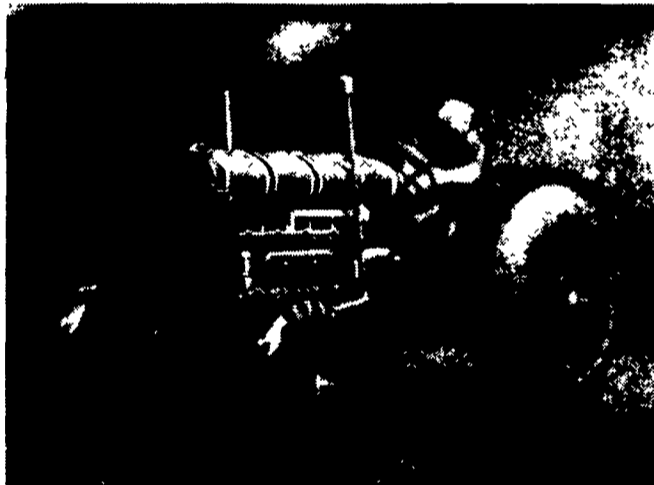
