Weekly Meat Production Under Federal Inspection

WASHINGTON, D.C., Sept 28 - (USDA-NASS) - Total red meat production under federal inspection for the week ending Saturday, Sept 29, was estimated at 920.6 million lb, according to the USDA's Agricultural Marketing Service. This was 2.7% higher than a week ago and 0.4% higher than a year ago. Cumulative meat production for the year to date was 2.5% lower compared to the previous year.




