A COUNTERTOP GARDEN

parsley, sage, rosemary, and thyme are among the herbs you can bring indoors if your herb gardens are still prospering and the first autumn frost hasn't hit You will need a deep pot to accommodate the long taproot of a paisley plant. Choose the smaller paisley plants for the best luck. Sage, marjoram, and thyme transplant easily, as does rosemary but all will need a spot that is not too dry and is in good light. A southern exposure helps to keep the herbs from getting too leggy. Pinching off leaves for your winter stews and casseroles will help keep the plants bushy. It you keep them on a windowsill over the kitchen sink, they'll soak up humidity and you II be reminded to use them






