

Weekly Meat Production Under Federal Inspection

WASHINGTON, D.C., Oct. 12- (USDA-NASS) - Total red meat production under federal inspection for the week ending Saturday, Oct. 13, was estimated at 908.4 million lb., according to the USDA's Agricultural Marketing Service. This was 1.3% higher than a week ago and 1.3% lower than a year ago. Cumulative meat production for the year to date was 2.4% lower compared to the previous year.


