MANHEIM (Lancaster Co.) — After five years of exhibiting market goats at the Manheim Community Farm Show, Sarah Landis finally joined her three sisters in the honor of taking home a grand championship trophy.

Landis said her champion is partly Boer as well as Tennessee Meat Goat.

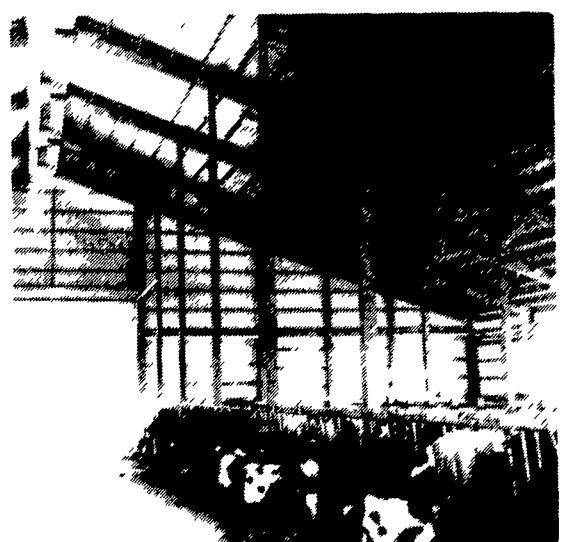

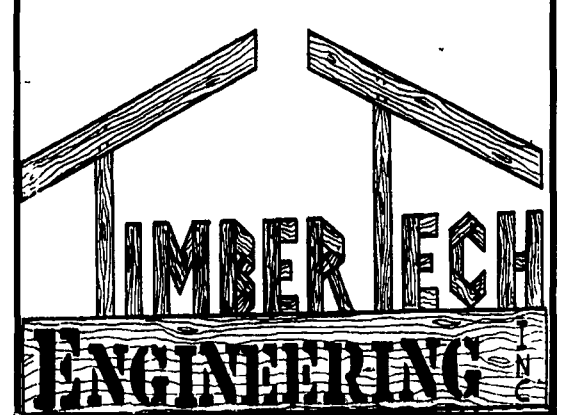
