Weekly Meat Production Under Federal Inspection

WASHINGTON, D.C., Oct 19- (USDA-NASS) - Total red meat production under federal inspection for the week ending Saturday, Oct 20, was estimated at 934 million lb, according to the USDA's Agricultural Marketing Service. This was 2.7% higher than a week ago and 1.9% lower than a year ago. Cumulative meat production for the year to date was 2.3% lower compared to the previous year.
