Trucklot buying activity continued light and unaggressive as dealers remained very cautious and were reluctant to build existing inventories. Offerings of breast items were ample and discounted. Dark meat cuts were adequate to fully adequate. Wings were readily available. Limited promotional activity was stimulating little movement in the retail sector, and distributors were beginning to thin floorstocks in preparation for the arrival of seasonal items. The market tone was barely steady to weak.

Mostly prices were unchanged on whites, balance of other items were mostly higher when compared to a week

earlier. Offerings were usually short on yolk, close balanced to tight on whole egg and adequate to available on whites. Demand was reported in a range of light to occasionally good. Undertone was barely steady to weak on whites, but fully steady to firm on yolks and whole egg. Liquid and frozen eggs (ingredients included) processed under federal inspection in the Eastern region for the week ending October 13, 2001 were 1% less than the previous week, and 6% less than a year ago.

NATIONAL YOUNG TURKEY PARTS AND BULK MEAT, Frozen, unless specified, cents per lb, delivered first receivers, part and full trucklots, as of Oct. 24, 2001.

Bulk parts trade sentiment on tom drums was steady to barely steady, hen drums steady to fully steady, tom and hen necks barely steady, full-cut wings at least steady, hen 2-joint wings steady, and tom 2-joint wings were barely steady. Bulk parts demand ranged light to fair. Offerings of tom drums, necks and 2-joint wings were adequate to fully adequate with drums the most available, hen drums and 2-joint wings light, full-cut wings light at best, hen necks fully adequate, and tails were mixed. Domestic trading was light on all items. Export trading centered on a fair volume of young frozen thigh meat. A part load of fresh wing meat traded at 86 cents delivered.

Movement of ready-to-cook whole birds and parts was seasonally slow. Seller offerings were readily available and in general difficult to place. Live supplies were at least moderate; weights were in a full range of light to heavy. Processing schedules were moderate to moderately heavy. Less than trucklot asking prices were unchanged at 54 to 68 cents. Trade sentiment was barely steady to weak on both whole birds and parts.

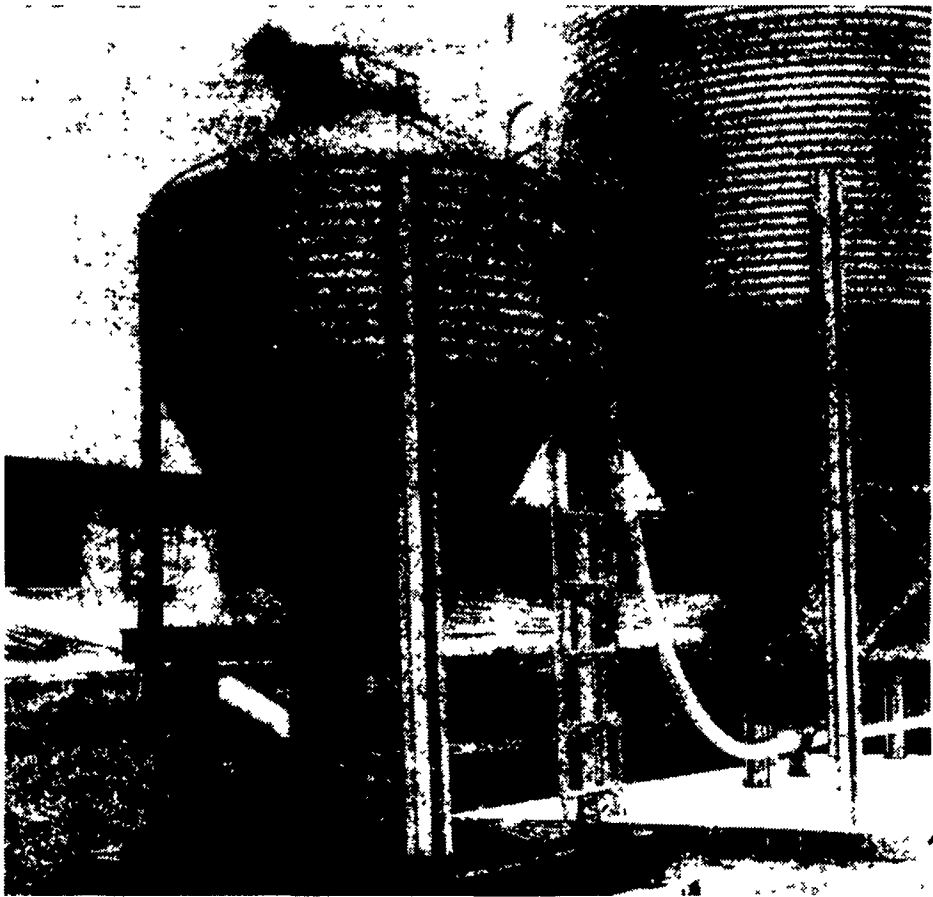

GSI Bulk Feed Tanks




