CORN BELT FEEDSTUFF: Wholesale Bids. Truck or Rail dollars per ton. Feedstuff prices were slightly mixed for the week. Plants were shutdown for the Christmas holiday. Some snow and cold weather moved across the Corn Belt region and demand picked up in places.

SOYBEAN MEAL: 44 percent rail bids 1.00 higher at 144.00-147.00. 48 percent rail 1.00 to 2.00 higher at 150.00-155.00. Truck 44 percent 1.00 higher at 146.00-150.00. 48 percent 1.00 higher at 152.00-161.00 per ton.

CORN BY-PRODUCTS: Gluten Feed 21 percent, Interior Points, steady at 58.00-72.00; Chicago steady to 5.00 lower at 64.00-70.00. 60 percent Gluten Meal, Interior Points, steady at 250.00-265.00; Chicago 5.00 to 10.00 lower at 245.00-260.00 per ton. Rail Hominy Feed, Central Illinois Points, steady to 2.00 higher at 60.00-62.00; truck 1.00 higher at 61.00-62.00. Crude Corn Oil 50 points lower at 21.50-22.50 cents per pound.

MIDLINGS: Northwest steady to 1.00 higher at 63.00-66.00; Buffalo steady To 2.00 higher at 67.00-75.00 per ton.
