The second component will focus on evaluating producers value-added business plans. Low margins are causing an increasing number of producers to explore ways to gain more control over the market for their products. Many value-added activities involve alliances along the value chain or group efforts such as alliances or cooperative arrangements. Unfortunately, for every effort that succeeds, another fails. This session looks






