Striving for higher prices in today's marketplace and higher yields while trimming production costs will be discussed by noted Ohio crop consultant Ed Winkle and Penn State's John Yocum.

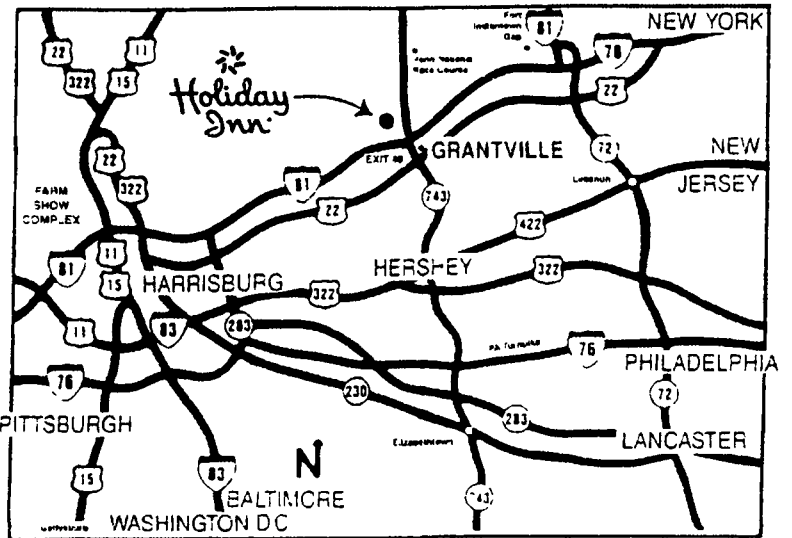
Gene Gantz, Ag Risk Strategies Inc., will provide information on crop-insurance based crop market-

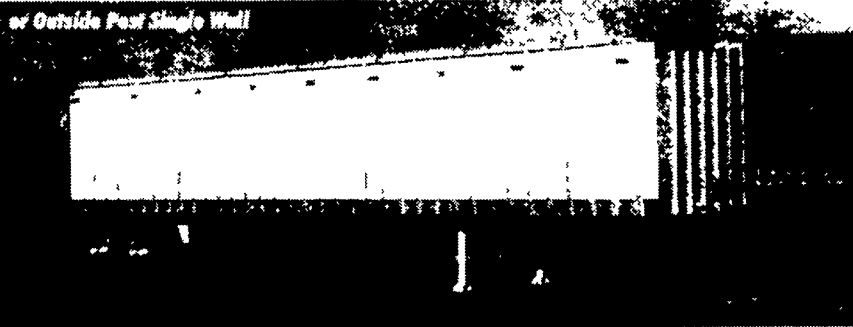

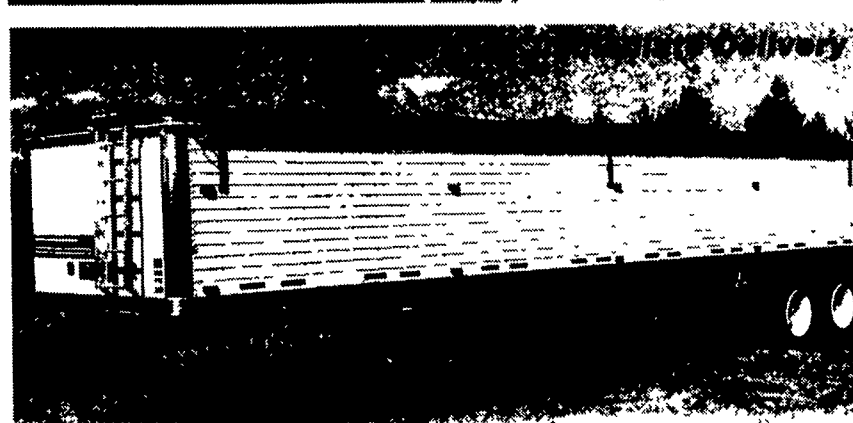
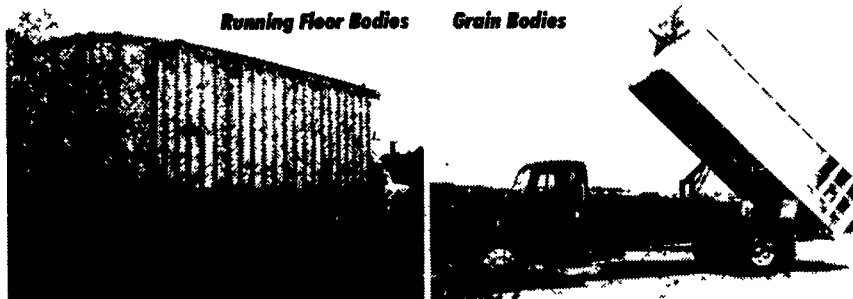
