DRINNON ESTATE SALE
A five-acre parcel with a large pond and stream, two-story farmhouse, stone bank barn and out-buildings sold for \$240,000 during a four-day public sale of real estate, antiques, dishes, collectibles and other personal property conducted Nov. 24, Dec. 1, Dec. 14 and Jan. 12 for the Hugh K. Drinnon estate, 472 Furnace Road, Birdsboro, Berks County.

The buyers were Karl and Linda Knauer, Geigertown, Berks County.

The Knauers also bought a 29-acre parcel, with a pond and stream, for \$185,000.

There were 808 bidders throughout the auction. The proceeds from the sale of personal prop-

erty exceeded \$155,000.

CIVIL WAR ITEMS OF FAMOUS SNYDER COUNTY SOLDIER

Corporal Henry Brown of Company D, 152nd Regiment, who resided in Freeburg PA, served faithfully for the Union for three years & three months. While stationed at Fortress Monroe, Virginia he and another Snyder Countian, Comrade Buck, had the distinguished honor of guarding Confederate President Jefferson Davis after he was captured by Union troops. After the war Mr Brown returned to his former trade of wagon making, and was later elected Associate Judge of Snyder County in 1889 and served until 1893. Honorable Henry Brown died on January 6, 1929. Being offered are his.
