I have a lavishly decorated, with flowers and gold trim, 4-inch teapot. It is marked with a crown and underneath a reverse "R and K." Can't find the reversed "R" in my Kovel's Dictionary of marks. Can you help?

R.G. — Naples, FL

You didn't look long enough. It is Dresden, mid-19th century. One of the 30 factories in that area of Germany. You'll find the mark in Kovel's Dictionary of marks, page 96(A).

Can you tell me if this violin is of any value? Inside is a paper label: "Antonio Stradivarius Croinesis, Facie bac Anno 1721 Made in Czechoslovakia."

Sorry to tell you your violin is one of the many copies sold in the 19th and early 20th century, in Europe and America, of famed violin maker Antonio Stradivarius. All the authentic pieces are known and registered. Your copy could sell for \$200.

Can you evaluate this wine press used by my husband's

grandparents to make wine. It is marked, "American Toys & Novelty Works, York, PA." Is there a market for it?

N.D.M. — Staten Island

There are many collectors of wines and wine memorabilia. It could sell in a shop for over \$500...especially if it still works. Show your picture to dealers at one of the big antique shows, or run an ad.

What could this mantel clock with a statue on each side be worth? The figures are of two ancient, Grecian-type women, and they and the clock frame are made of pewter.

H.M.N. — Cape Coral, FL

Your 19th century lamp, made of spelter (a white metal) could sell at auction for \$900 to \$1,200.

I have a pair of tiles marked Minton. I think they depict characters from a Shakespeare play. What could they be worth?

E.S. — Chicago, Ill.

A similar pair, c.1860, sold at auction for \$200.

zines and newspapers became in some cases an art form. Food and drug containers used art and product symbols to attract buyers. In the 1930s Log Cabin syrup was packaged in a colorful tin in the form of a log cabin. Bakers' cocoa had a Dutch costumed woman on their containers. At the same time pretty girls became a way to sell a product and were used on Coca Cola trays. These days the likeness of Colonel Sanders is used as an advertising symbol for Kentucky Fried Chicken.

Beginning collectors don't have to pay a fortune to start an advertising collection. The first thing is to zero in on a category such as food, tobacco, soft drinks, etc. Next time you are in a grocery store or a hotel gift

shop see what catches your eye. I mention hotels because famous hotels such as The Plaza in New York have candy tins depicting the hotel facade.

Periodically you'll come across a country auction with cardboard cereal boxes dating back to the 1940s. Some people never throw anything out. Condition is all important as well as age. Cleaning products no longer being sold often had colorful advertising. Old Dutch Cleanser with the figure of a Dutch costumed woman, dating to the 1920s-1930s and Gold Dust cleanser with its' trade mark Afro-American twins, from the same era, could be the basis of a collection.

The fun of collecting advertising memorabilia is that you never know where you'll find it. Ashtrays, figures and tearsheets are all worth collecting.
