

**Weekly Meat Production Under Federal Inspection**

WASHINGTON, D.C., Jan 25- (USDA-NASS) - Total red meat production under federal inspection for the week ending Sat., Jan. 26, was estimated at 886.4 million lb, according to the USDA's Agricultural Marketing Service. This was 4.1% higher than a week ago and 1.5% higher than a year ago. Cumulative meat production for the year to date was 2.0% lower compared to the previous year.

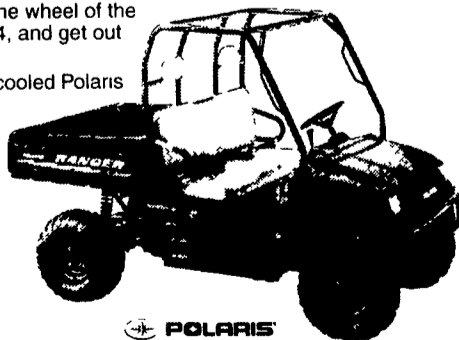
