OUT-OF-GINGER GINGERBREAD
1/2 cup (1 stick) butter
3/4 cup molasses
1/2 cup boiling water
3.4 cup sugar
1 egg
1 teaspoon cinnamon
1 2 teaspoon ground cloves
1 2 teaspoon nutmeg
1 2 teaspoon baking soda
1-1 2 cups flour

Preheat oven to 350°F. Grease and flour an 8x8-inch baking pan. In a pot over low heat, melt butter, stir in molasses, water and sugar. Remove from heat and add egg. Sift dry ingredients together and add them to the butter mixture. Pour into pan and bake for 30 minutes.
