(Continued from Page A27) head accounting for 21 percent of the state inventory. He added that 70 percent of the operations have less than 99 head and account for 3 percent of the inventory.

Moore sees more of the smaller operations going out of business and expansion continuing in others. While commenting on the state hog farmers, he said that Pennsylvania producers are doing a good job in their sow far-

rowings with an average of 8.80 pigs saved per litter compared to the 8.78 U.S. average.

All factors discussed — competitive meats, feed supplies and costs, Futures contract prices, consumer incomes, government price supports — Moore predicted 2002 will be a fairly profitable year for pork producers.
