NATIONAL BOXED BEEF Boxed beef generally steady on light to moderate demand and offerings. Select and Choice rib and loin cuts generally steady, while chuck and rounds steady to weak. Beef trimmings weak on light to moderate demand and offerings. Estimated composite cutout value of Choice 1-3 600-750 lbs carcasses up 19 at 122.45, 750-900 lbs dn 27 at 119.98, Select 1-3, 600-750 lbs up 41 at 118.12, 750-900 lbs down 33 at 116.73, based on 120 08 loads of Choice cuts, 97.50, loads of Select cuts, 38.17 loads of trimmings, and 44.90 loads of coarse ground trimmings.

Estimated carcass price equivalent value of Choice 1-3 600-750 lbs up 10 at 113.40 750-900 lbs dn 24 at 111.57, Select 1-3 600-750 lbs up 21 at 108.92, 750-900 lbs dn 28 at 108.00. Current index reflects the equivalent of 335,822 head of cattle.

NATIONAL CARIOT BFFF The Cutter cow carcass gross cutout value was estimated at 95.87, unchanged.

By-Product Drop Value Hide and offal from a typical slaughter steer was estimated at 6.80, unchanged.

NATIONAL CARLOT PORK Sales reported on 50.63 loads of pork cuts and 26.0 loads of trim/process pork. Compared to Monday's close. Fresh loins mostly 2.00 lower, butts generally steady. Skinned hams 17-20 lbs steady to firm, 20-23 lbs steady, 23-27 lbs 2.00-4.00 lower seedless bellies 14-16 lbs steady to firm, lean trimmings steady to 1.00 lower. Trading slow to moderate, with light to moderate demand and offerings.

Calculations for a 185 lb Pork Carcass 51-52 percent lean 0.80" - 0.99" back fat at last rib - 58.13, down 32. Loins bone in fresh 1/4 inch trim 21 lb/down/light 105.00-108.00 Hams bone in trimmed 17-20 lbs trim spec 1.60-00-63.50, 20-23 lbs trim spec 1.51.00 Seedless bellies 14-16 lbs 69.00-71.00 16-18 lbs 66.50.
