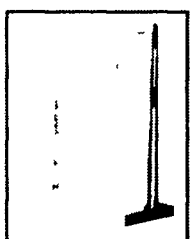
"The biggest benefit is the labor savings."

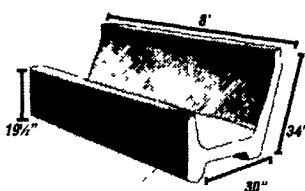

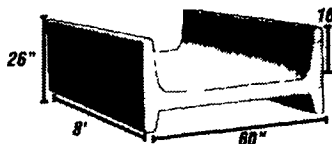

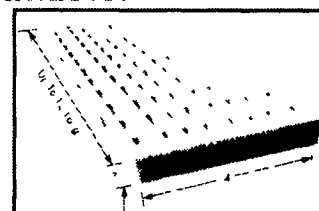
T-wall Bunker Silo



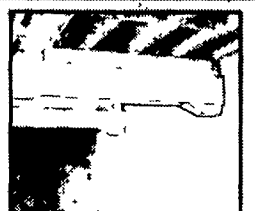
Slant-back J-style Feed Bunker
