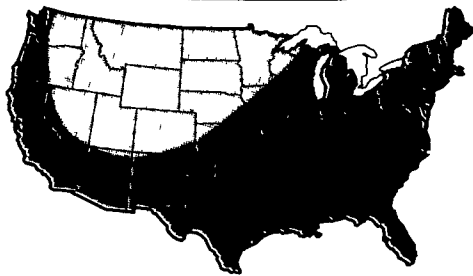

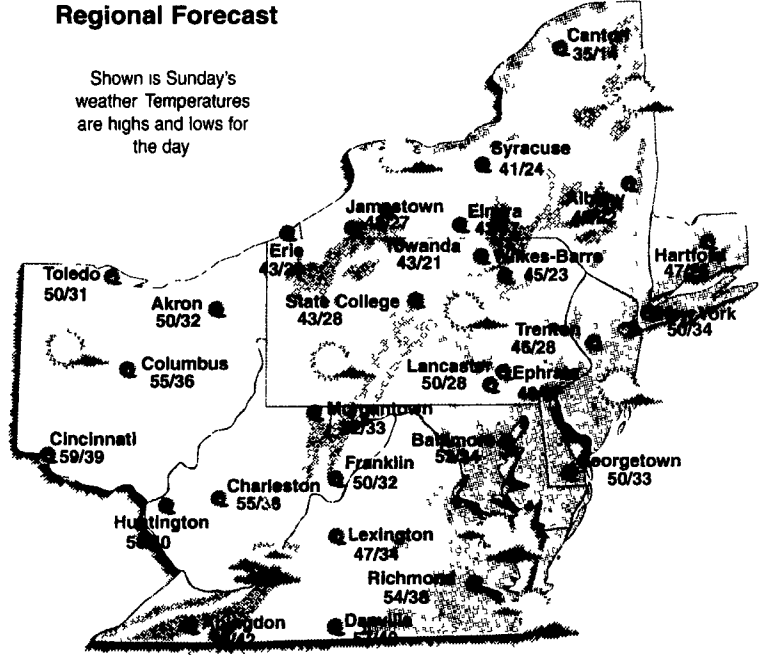

Farming Forecast

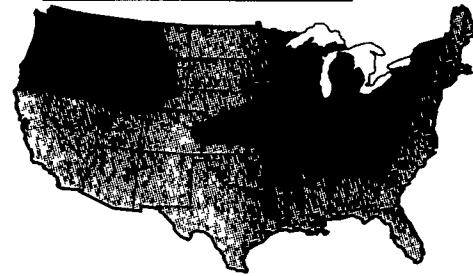

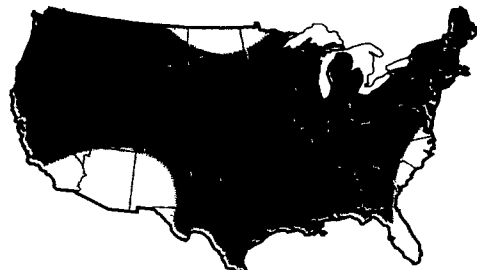
