Imari Porcelain Can Be Chinese Or Japanese
When you think of colorful Imari porcelains and pottery what comes to mind is that it was made in Japan. So it was, but it was also being copied by the Chinese in the early 18th century. Today it is just as costly, sometimes more than the Japanese.

Ben Edwards III became fascinated with Chinese Imari around 1980

His first purchase was a barber's basin purchased in an antiques shop for \$950. By the time he retired as Chairman, CEO and President of A.G. Edwards, last March, he had amassed almost 3,000 pieces of mostly Chinese Imari. It recently sold at Christie's for a whopping \$1,740,393. The second half of the collection will be sold next January

Pieces sold well over estimate, showing a revived interest in the category. A large pair of Chinese Imari jars and covers from the first half of the 18th century were estimated at \$7,000-10,000 sold for \$30,550.

The original Imari was first made in Japan around 1640-46. The usual color combinations are iron red and cobalt blue with gold accents on a white ground. The designs were often set in panels, sometimes filled with flowers and foliage. Other subjects included figures, flying cranes, the phoenix and a Japanese monster known as Kirin.

Fishes, dogs and other animals were also popular. Only rarely were landscapes used.

Between 1660 and 1745 Imari became the the collecting vogue for wealthy Europeans.

The colorful designs were used as decorative accents rather than tableware. Exceptions were teapots. The pieces were copied for the most part from Western forms. The chargers, vases and ewers were then decorated in the Imari palette. However, molded figures followed traditional Japanese subjects.

Chinese Imari porcelain was also created for not only many of Europe's wealthy families during

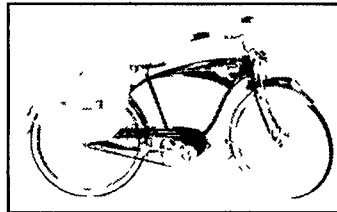
