this time, but royalty as well Among the pieces in the Edwards collection are those decorated with the royal arms of France, from a dinner service for the young Louis XV and his uncle, the Regent, in about 1720. Many of the royalty commissioned pieces with the family coat of arms. A Chinese Imari barber's bowl has the arms of Gelderlant, c.1720 By the early 19th century collectors turned to new collecting trends. It took displays of Imari at the Philadelphia Centennial(1876) to briefly revive interest.

Once again, in the late 1970s Jap-

anese porcelains were recognized for their beauty and quality; including Imari. CLUES: The average collector during


the 1970s didn't know about Chinese Imari. As far as they were concerned it was all Japanese. However as interest grew, so did research.

Chinese Imari was rediscovered and the clues that made it identifiable. For example, Chinese Imari is thin and dense with a greenish look. Japanese Imari has a grayish tint and is coarser.

There are subtle color contrasts as well. The Japanese red is Indian red while the

Chinese red is an iron red, coral color. The Japanese is opaque. The Japanese black brownish is while the Chinese is greenish. The spur marks used as supports during firing appear on Japanese pieces but not usually on Chinese Imari.

Early pieces of Japanese Imari are usually unmarked. A few had a blue painted leaf mark. Pieces with faked character marks were done in the 19th century by French porcelain faker Samson.
