How To Make A Palm Branch Cross

Last year, many people requested a pattern for making a palm branch cross in the You Ask. You Answer column. Mrs Luther Spangler, York Springs, contributed the following pattern, complete with illustrations




Now take the longer section and fold it up to where the cross arm will be located. Fold this over so the branch has a triangular fold at this point. (see Fig 2).

Here you will wrap this cross piece three times around the upright



Now you will extend the cross piece out from the upright piece at the point where you wrapped the upright three times. About the same length as the upper area of the cross fold the cross piece back to the center (see Fig 3)

Making the cross piece go past the center, fold the branch back to the center



At the center, fold the branch up and then thread the branch through the wrapping you made at the cross piece. Wrap this two

or three times in order to hold the cross piece firmly to the upright piece Now you have an Easter Cross from Palm Branches
