The porcelain they developed was so thin it was likened to an eggshell.

The Belleek we are most familiar with with its intricated designs was first made in 1857 at D.McBirney and Company in County Feremanagh, Belleek, Ireland. Most was trimmed with applied floral and leaf designs. It is still being made. It can be dated by its' many marks and types of glazes. The earliest pieces can sell for \$3,000 or more. Cabinet sets consisting of a tray, cups and saucers, even into the early 20th century can sell at auction for over a thousand dollars.

So much was made in both utilitarian and decorative forms that it is still possible to start and affordable collection.

Figures, openware baskets are possibilities.

Seashell shaped pieces are among the most recognizable. They were made by both American and Irish companies.
