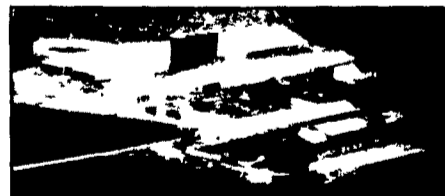

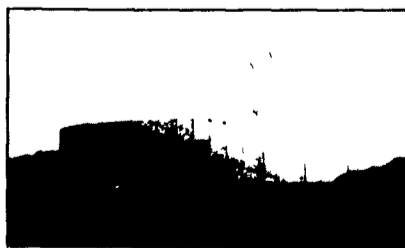
Far Left: 1-Million Gallon Circular Manure Storage Tank

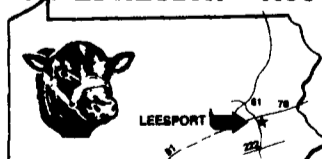
