has joined a broad coalition of agriculture groups, renewable fuel producers and organizations concerned with the country's air quality in a recent letter to the U.S. Senate urging enactment of a renewable fuels standard (RFS)

According to NFU President Leland Swenson, creating a RFS would triple ethanol production over the next decade by requiring that a small percentage of renewable fuels, such as ethanol and biodiesel, be blended into motor fuels. Pending legislation would increase renewable fuels use from two billion gallons in 2003 to five billion gallons in 2012.

"The Renewable Fuels Standard provides great opportunities for farmers and consumers by aiding the pursuit of sound farm, environmental, security and economic polices," Swenson said. "It will help increase market prices for commodities, enhance the security of our tuer supply, and ensure the availability of gas and diesel additives that help the environment.

Processing plants that produce biofuels are popping up across the nation," Swenson added. "Many of these facilities are farmer-owned cooperatives. Farmers and processors are gearing up to meet the new environmental and energy security challenges.'
