Offerings ranged from light at best for prompt deliveries to adequate for deferred. Domestic and export trading was light on all items with activity centered on frozen young hen thigh meat and hen 2-joint wings for domestic shipments.

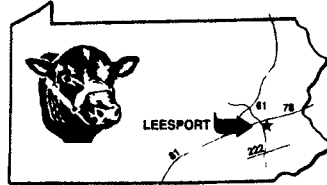
