CLUES: You never know when or where you'll discover an example of an illustration by a woman artist. Like other categories, illustrations travel far from place of origin. They can be done in many media from pen and ink and pastels to oil, watercolors or mixed media.

Since signatures add to the value, it is important to identify them. "The Illustrator In America, 1860-2000" by Walt Reed, is a good source of reference with illustrated signatures, biographical sketches and examples by American illustrators. Priced at \$49.95.

Antiques Questions And Answers

I bought this trunk at an auction. It says Anno 1620 on it. It is trimmed with ironwork in patterns. It looks like this trunk was once trimmed in velvet. It has heavy pull out drawers on the bottom. Any info appreciated.

L.B. - Sorrento, FL

What you have is a 19th century Continental chest, possibly German. From your photo it has been faked, but unfortunately the faker made some mistakes. The onion (ball) feet weren't used till 1694. The words "Anno 1620 have been recently painted. A similar chest sold at auction last year for \$2,500.

Can you tell me anything about this piece of Imari belonging to my late aunt? No marks on the bottom.

D.B. - Naples, FL

I can't tell from a photo if your covered compote is Japanese or Chinese.

However since your piece is quite unusual and rare it could sell at auction for over \$6,000.

This wooden ice box was given to me by my in-laws. I stripped off old white paint and refinished it. It has a name on it; "White Mountain Porcelain." Can you tell the age and value?

C.R.S. - North Arello, PA

Your oak, wood ice box could sell at auction for \$200 to \$500.

Can you tell me who made this swirled, blue and white glass vase, 14 1/2" high. I bought it at auction in the 1980s.

K.B. - Cedar Rapids-IO (collect.Journal)

Your bud vase is known as shaded, opalescent glass and was originally made in the late 19th century by several Ameri-

can glass houses.

Unfortunately, it was reproduced from the 1960s on. If authentic, it could sell at auction for around \$125.

This table was left to me and I know nothing about it. As you see, the ends are a flat carving of a kneeling, nude woman.

T.S.-Salt Springs, FL

Your library table is in the Art Deco style, probably European, dating 1920s. The black marble top adds to the value. A dealer could price it at \$2,000 to \$5,000.

This clock is of gilt metal. It is topped with the figure of an eagle and mounted on a black marble, with gilt rococo feet. It says "Ansonia Clock Co., New York, U.S.A. Patented June 13, 1882. It strikes on the hour and half hour. What is it worth?

T.K. - Salsburg, PA

Your mantle clock could sell for over \$2,000 in a shop.

I have a pottery figure of a fox that my grandmother brought over from England around 1900. It is about six inches long. No marks. What can you tell from this photo?

D.M. - Dallas, TX

You appear to have a late 19th century Staffordshire figure. It could sell at auction for around \$300 or more.

My late uncle who had belonged to the Shriners Fraternal Organization left me his felt Fez hat. Since I am not interested in it, what kind of value does it have?

T.S. - Staten Island, NY

The Warman's Price Guide lists a Shriners felt Fez hat at \$25.

I have a silver Kiddush cup my grandmother brought from Russia when she came to America around 1900. It is
