

THE DAWN OF THE LP

Dr. Peter Goldmark's engineering team from CBS developed the microgroove LP vinylite record Columbia Records copyrighted the term LP which stands for "long-playing." The 12-inch discs played for 23 minutes per side at the new speed of 33 1/3 rpm—19 minutes longer than the previous 78-rpm versions. The use of vinylite (which replaced the brittle shellac versions) and microgrooves allowed more playing time per side and reduced surface noise. On June 21, 1948, the LP record was publicly introduced at the Waldorf-Astoria Hotel in New York City. Who was the first LP-teatured musician? Violinist Yehudi Menuhin. Can you remember the first LP you bought?

CITRUS-DRESSED SUMMER VEGGIES

1 pound vegetables, such as asparagus, zucchini strips, carrots, yellow squash
1 tablespoon olive oil
2 tablespoons fresh lemon juice
2 tablespoons orange juice
cayenne pepper, to taste
salt and pepper, to taste
