USDA Market News USDA Carlot Meat 4:00 Summary: Compared to Previous Day, Prices in Dollars per hundred-weight, Equated to FOB Omaha Basis.

BOXED BEEF CUTS: Boxed beef cut-out values generally steady on moderate demand and offerings. Select and Choice rib, chuck and round generally steady. Select loin steady, while Choice loin lower. Beef trimmings firm on moderate to fairly good demand and moderate offerings.

Estimated composite cutout value of Choice 1-3, 600-750 lbs carcasses up .10 at 113.98, 750-900 lbs up .11 at 114.72; Select 1-3, 600-750 lbs up .06 at 107.99, 750-900 lbs up .28 at 108.33; based on 142.36 loads of Choice cuts, 118.69 loads of Select cuts, 60.39 loads of trimmings, and 46.68 loads of coarse ground trimmings.

Estimated carcass price equivalent value of Choice 1-3, 600-750 lbs up .07 at 102.04, 750-900 lbs up .07 at 102.46; Select 1-3, 600-750 lbs up .04 at 94.82, 750-900 lbs up .17 at 95.01. Current index reflects the equivalent of 360,333 head of cattle.

NATIONAL CARLOT BEEF: The Cutter cow carcass gross cutout value was estimated at 94.21, unchanged.

By-Product Drop Value: Hide and offal from a typical slaughter steer was estimated at 7.70, down .03.

NATIONAL CARLOT PORK: Sales reported on 56.88 loads of pork cuts and 26.0 loads of trim/process pork. Compared to Monday's close: Fresh loins steady to weak; butts 3.00 higher; skinned hams 1.00-2.00 higher; seedless bellies mostly 2.00 higher; lean trimmings mostly 4.00-7.00 lower. Trading slow to moderate, with light to moderate demand and offerings.

Calculations for a 185 lb Pork Carcass 51-52 percent lean 0.80" -0.99" back fat at last rib — 58.78, up .32. Loins bone in fresh 1/4 inch trim 21 lb/down/light 105.00-133.00. Hams bone in trimmed, 17-20 lbs trim spec 1, 37.00-38.00; 20-23 lbs trim spec 1, 39.00. Seedless bellies 12-14 lbs 72.00; 14-16 lbs 74.00; 16-18 lbs 71.00.

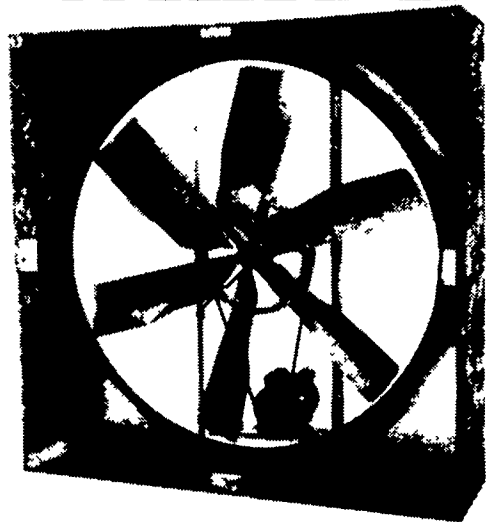
