Consider your grandmother's alphabet sampler a family heirloom. The fact that it is signed and dated 1880, adds to the value.

However if several colors were used along with designs and animal, flower or bird motifs, it would be worth more than its shop price of around

My mother-in-law asked me to find out the value of this 12-inch high china vase with a picture of a standing woman in a long gown and cape.

It has no mark on the bottom. G.F. - Waverly, IO

Your vase is "portrait ware" popular in the late 19th century. It was made by many European manufacturers and ofich unmarked when made be-fore 1890. Value depends on whether it is a transfer print or hand painted. If the latter, look for an artist's signature.

Popular subjects included royalty. It could sell in a shop for \$200 if a transfer print. Over \$500 if hand painted.

purchased a Dr. Thornton print, with the following printed on it: "Reinagle Siena ARA Ponxt, Night Blooming Cereus, London. Published by Dr. Thornton. Jan 1, 1812. It is in excellent condition though the brown paper backing is showing its age. I haven't examined it out of the

Since I have willed it to dear friends I would like to tell them what they are to receive.

Your mentioning "brown paper backing showing" leads me to believe that your print was "laid down"; glued to a backing as was common in the late 19th, early 20th century. This lowers the value. However, it can be professionally removed, depending on the value of the print. Prices for Dr. Thornton's prints range from \$2,200 to \$14,000 in galleries, such as Kenyon-Oppenheimer, in Chicago (who also restore prints). Send a photo to them listing size, etc. at 410 N. 
