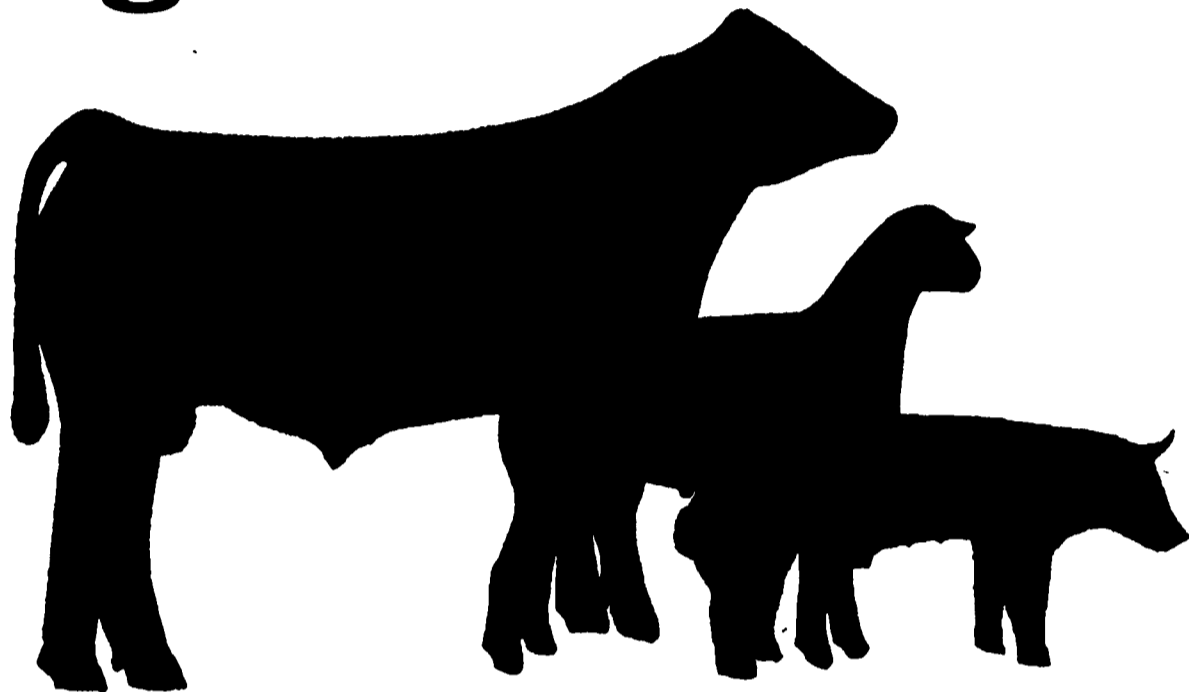


LIVESTOCK EVALUATION CENTER
