## **2002 PENNSYLVANIA HAY SHOW**

A feature of Penn State Ag Progress Days, Aug. 20-22 Sponsored by the PFGC and Penn State Cooperative Extension

The location of the Hay Show tent is at the end of East 5th Street. Hay samples delivered to Ag Progress Days on Tuesday, Aug. 20 should be dropped off at the special HAY SAMPLE DROP OFF POINT located along the east entrance to Ag Progress Days. Deadline for sample delivery is 10 a.m. Aug. 20.

SECTION 1 Field Cured or Partially Field Cured Plus Mow Finish (No Heat) (no hay preservatives)

**Class 1 Alfalfa - First Cutting** Alfalfa from stands at least one year old with not over 10 percent grasses

**Class 2 Alfalfa - Later Cutting** Alfalfa with not over 10 percent grasses

Class 3 Alfalfa Grass Mixed - First Cutting A mixture of alfalfa and grass with over 10 percent but not over 50 percent grasses

**Class 4 Alfalfa Grass Mixed - Later Cutting** A mixture of alfalfa and grass with over 10 percent but not over 50 percent grasses

**Class 5 Clover** Clover with not over 20 percent grasses

**Class 6 Clover Grass Mixed** A mixture of clover and grass with over 20 percent but not over 50 percent grasses

**Class 7 Grass - First cutting** Pure species or mixtures of grasses containing not over 10 percent legume

**Class 8 Grass - Later cutting** Pure species or mixtures of grasses containing not over 10 percent legume

Class 9 Mixed Hay - More than 50% legumes Any mixture not classified in the previous classes but which contain 50 percent or more legumes in combination with grasses.

Class 10 Mixed Hay - More than 50% grasses Any mixture not classified in the previous classes but which contain 50 percent or more grass in combination with alfalta, clover, or birdstoot tretoil.

SECTION II Partially Field Cured Plus Heat Dried (no hay preservatives)

**Class 11 Alfalta - First cutting** Alfalta from stands at least one year old with not over 10 percent grasses

**Class 12 Alfalta - Later cutting** Altalta with not over 10 percent grasses

**Class 13 Alfalfa Grass Mixed - First Cutting** A mixture of alfalfa and grass with over 10 percent but not over 50 percent grasses

**Class 14 Alfalfa Grass Mixed - Later Cutting** A mixture of alfalfa and grass with over 10 percent but not over 50 percent grasses

Class 15 Clover Clove, with not over 20 percent grasses

**Class 16 Clover Grass Mixed** A mixture t clover and grass with over 20 percent but not over 50 percent grasses

**Class 17 Grass - First cutting** Pure species or mixtures of grasses containing not over 10 percent legume

**Class 18 Grass - Later cutting** Pure species or mixtures of grasses containing not over 10 percent legume

Class 19 Mixed Hay - More than 50% legumes Any mixture not classified in the previous classes but which contain 50 percent or more legumes in combination with grasses.

Class 20 Mixed Hay - More than 50% grasses Any mixture not classified in the previous classes but which contain 50 percent or more grass in combination with alfalfa. clover, or birdstoot trefoil.

SECTION III Partially Field Cured Plus Hay Preservative

**Class 21 Alfalfa - First cutting** Alfalfa from stands at least one year old with not over 10 percent grasses

**Class 22 Alfalfa - Later cutting** Alfalfa with not over 10 percent grasses

**Class 23 Alfalfa Grass Mixed - First Cutting** A mixture of alfalfa and grass with over 10 percent but not over 50 percent grasses

**Class 27 Grass - First cutting** Pure species or mixtures of grasses containing not over 10 percent legume

Class 29 Mixed Hay - More than 50% legumes Any mixture not classified in the previous classes but which contain 50 percent or more legumes in combination with grasses.

Class 30 Mixed Hay - More than 50% grasses Any mixture not classified in the previous classes but which contain 50 percent or more grass in combination with alfalfa, clover, or birdstoot tretoil.
