## Red Angus Releases Year Results

Red Angus has posted a year of setting breed records for memberships, registrations, transfers, and domestic semen sales. Red Angus has also maintained its lead in semen exports over U.S. beef breeds.

Red Angus' USDA Processed Verified Feeder Calf Certification Program enrolled just under 97,000 head.

Red Angus also released the industry's first reproductive sire summary with genetic predictions. The carcass EPD program also continues to grow with over 320,000 head now described with genetic predictions.

After ranking twelfth in registrations as recently as 1990, Red Angus has become the fifth largest breed in the nation.

New this past year to the Red Angus Association was the addition of Angus Plus to the registry. These cattle are black or red Angus-Brahman derivatives with the goal of minimizing the ear influence in the cattle while still maintaining heat tolerance. These cattle are required to adhere to Red Angus' strict Total Herd Reporting program giving them the most reliable performance data available in the industry.
