

Bradford County 4-H, FFA Livestock Roundup At Troy Fair

TROY (Bradford Co.) — Completing their swine, beef and lamb projects for this year, over 100 youths participated in the Bradford County 4-H and FFA Livestock Roundup at the Troy Fair before hundreds of spectators.

SWINE: In the swine show, 79 youths competed for prizes. Grand champion fitter and showman was Hillary Lindsey of the Champion Chargers 4-H Club. She also was the champion from the intermediate (12-14) age bracket. The champion junior fitter and showman was Erica Kuhlman of the Udder Bunch 4-H Club and senior champion was Jenny Eick of the Hill'n Dale 4-H Club.

The grand champion pig was shown by Meredith Hennip of the Udder Bunch 4-H Club and the reserve grand champion by Eliza-

beth Hennip.

In the lightweight swine class, first place blue went to Dann Laudermilch of the Northeast Ag and Home Ec Club; 2nd place, Jason Kenyon, Mt. Pisgah Raiders 4-H Club; and third, Matthew Roehrig, the Country Kids 4-H Club. In the light mediumweight class, first place blue went to Caitlyn Jackson, the Clever Clovers; and 2nd, Kara Kneller, Kountry Kritters 4-H Club.

In the mediumweight swine class, first place blue was received by Corey White, Champion Chargers; 2nd, Danielle Carlson, Granville Squealers; 3rd, Jessica Rockwell, Mt. Pisgah Raiders; and 4th, Kyle Howland, the Udder Bunch 4-H Club.

In the heavy mediumweight swine class, first blue was received by Jodi Crawford and

2nd, Marc Waltemeyer, the Udder Bunch. In the light heavy-weight class, first place blue was received by Meredith Hennip; 2nd, Jamie Crawford; and 3rd, Shelby Crawford. In the medium heavyweight class, first place blue was won by Elisabeth Hennip; 2nd, Stephen Laudermilch; and 3rd, by Carrie Wilson, the Udder Bunch 4-H Club.

In the heavyweight swine divi-

sion, first place blue was received by Erica Kuhlman of the Udder Bunch; 2nd, Daniel Suarez, the Navigators.

BEEF: Fifteen youth participated in the beef show.

Steers, Lambs, And Swine Sold At Troy Livestock Auction

TROY (Bradford Co.) - Numerous buyers gathered to bid at the annual Troy Fair Livestock auction conducted recently. Prices remained steady

throughout the sale as steers, pigs and lambs crossed the auction block.

Fourteen steers were sold with an average price per pound of \$.82.

Williams Lubricants purchased the grand champion steer from Raya Shores for \$1.20. The reserve champion, raised by Rye Mathers, was purchased by Tuscarora Wayne Mutual Insurance for \$1.05. Prices ranged from \$1.20 to \$.60 per pound.

Eighteen lambs were sold commanding an average price of \$1.18 per pound.

The grand champion, raised by Emily Blade, brought the highest price of \$2.25 per pound. Wyalusing Livestock Market purchased the champion. The reserve grand champion, raised by Ei-

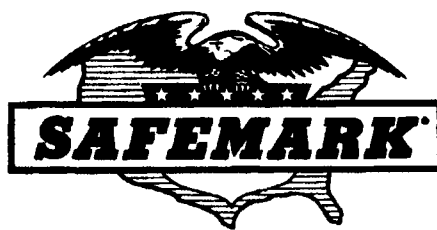

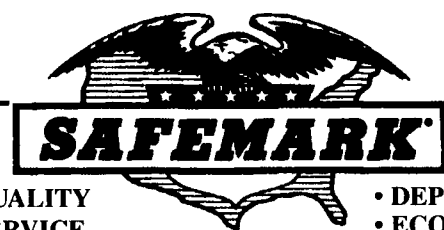
