DEVON (Chester Co.) — The 33rd annual Lincoln Americans Gold Cup, Sept. 12-15 at the Devon show grounds, features grand prix jumping, open speed, intermediate, amateur owner and pony jumper classes and side saddle classes. The Gold Cup benefits the University of Pennsylvania School of Veterinary Medicine and its large animal facility, New Bolton Center and Main Line Rescue. Entertainment includes exhibitions, a Celebrity Dog Show, pony rides, a children's art con-

The American Gold Cup weekend features two grand prix classes, the \$35,000 Welcome Stake, a World Cup qualifier, Friday evening, and the \$60,000 Gold Cup Sunday afternoon. The American Gold Cup is one leg of the prestigious triple crown of show jumping, with the Invitational and the American Grand-

prix Association Championship being the other two.
