

### Young Turkey Parts And Bulk Meat

NATIONAL YOUNG TURKEY PARTS AND BULK MEAT, Frozen, unless specified, cents per lb. delivered first receivers, part and full trucklots, as of August 20, 2002.

Trade sentiment was steady to firm on fresh tom breast meat and fresh de-strapped tenderloins, fresh wing meat steady. Frozen white meat trade sentiment was steady to instances weak. Demand was in a full range on fresh white meat mostly moderate, frozen light. Offerings of fresh white meat ranged from short to instances available. Domestic trading centered on a fair volume of frozen tom breast meat and fresh mechanically separated turkey, balance of domestic and export trading light. Fresh wing meat traded at 56 cents and frozen Grade A non-basted 16-20 lb. breasts 105 cents delivered domestic.

from the previous week. The price for US 500 pound Barrels adjusted to 38 percent moisture averaged \$1.09 per pound, up 1.6 cents from the previous week.





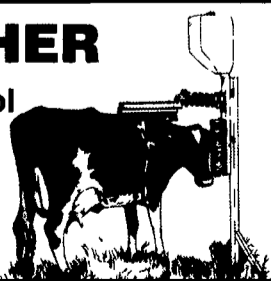
