She is owned by Kristen and Ashley Fisher ages 14 and 17, daughters of Keith Fisher of New Enterprise.

Judges Jason Myers and daughter, Kelly Myers Zepp, both found her to be an outstanding cow.

Ronnie and Pam Morse of Clearville took reserve honors with a Holstein.

"This fair always brings outstanding entries," said judge Myers. "All of the champions are outstanding but these two stand out a little above the rest."


