Pictured here are the first place teams and high scoring individuals in the diversified competitions.



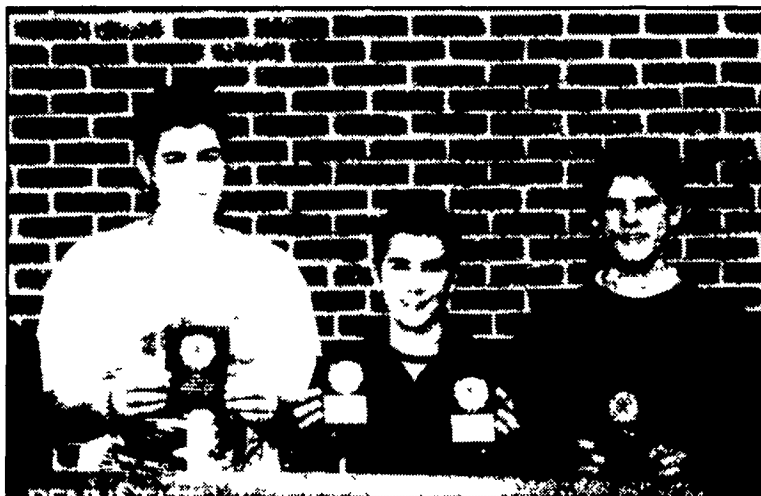

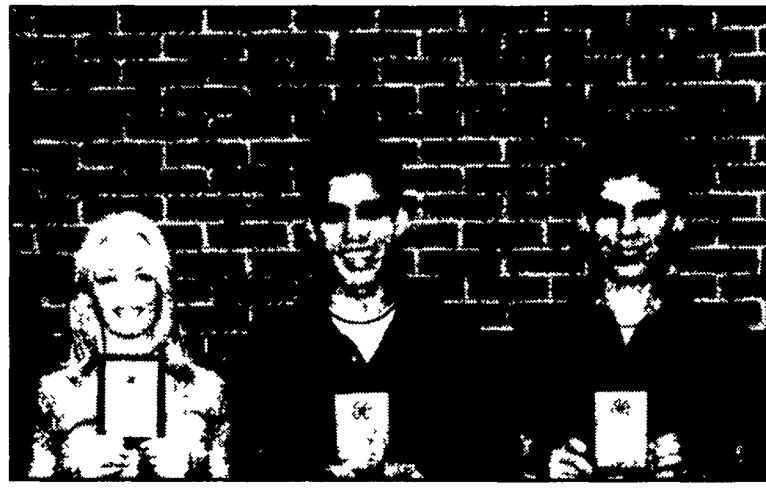

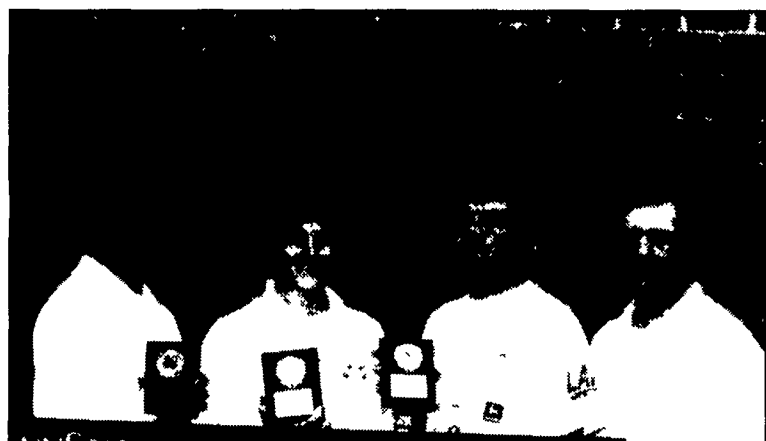

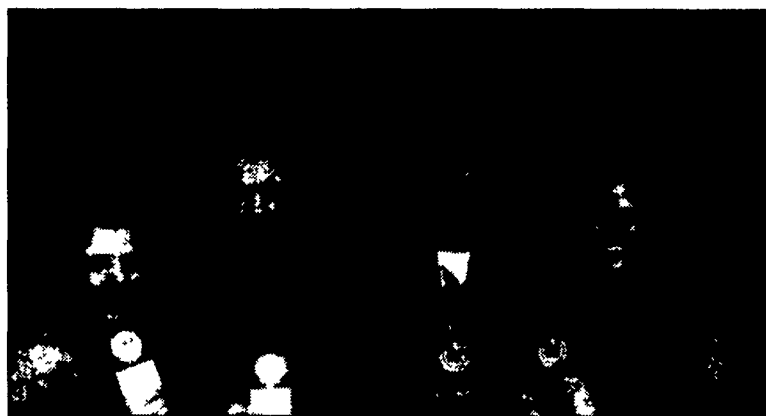
