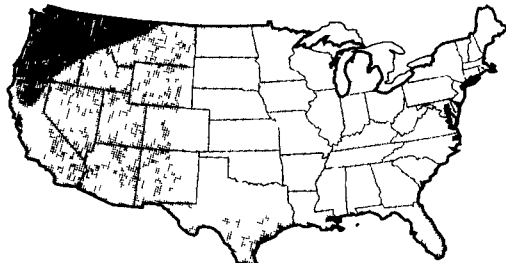

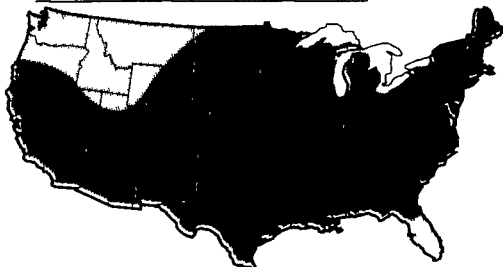

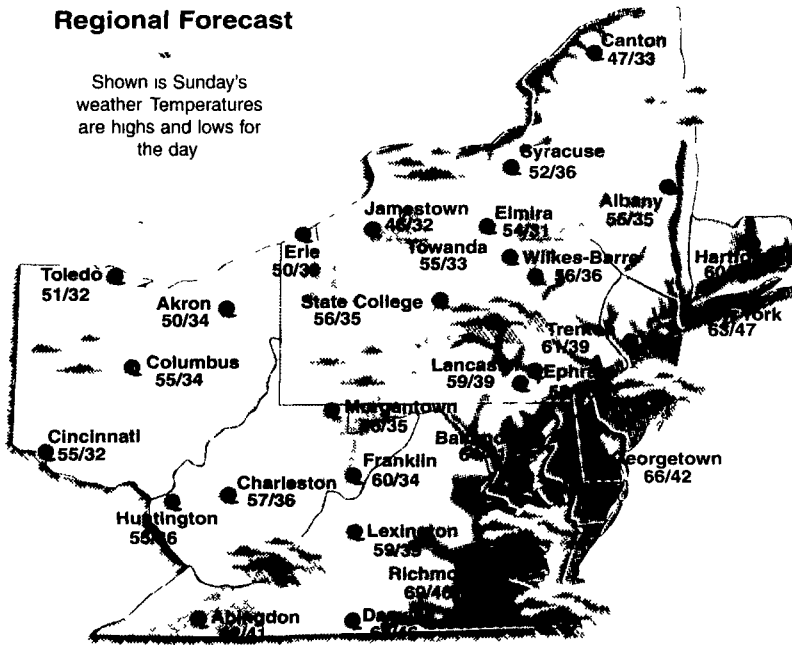

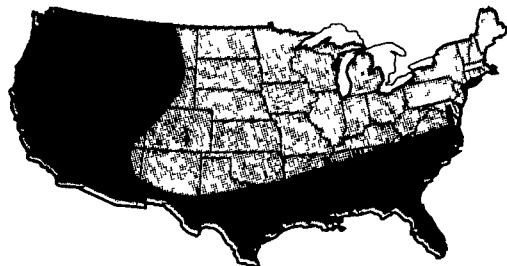
Shown is Sunday's weather. Temperatures are highs and lows for the day.



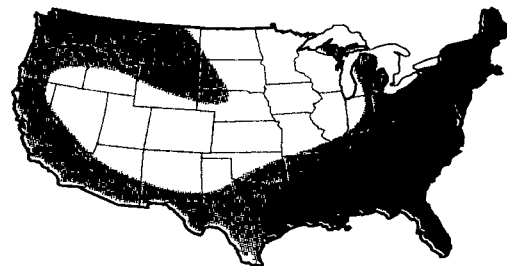
