Heritage Center Museum Of Lancaster County Announces Upcoming Family Workshop

LANCASTER (Lancaster Co.) — The Heritage Center Museum Lancaster County (located on historic Penn Square in downtown Lancaster) announces its winter workshop scheduled for Saturday, Jan. 18 and 25 in two half-day sessions:

Session A is from 9 a.m.-noon. Session B is from 1-4 p.m. A skilled instructor will teach participants the 18th century art of bronze stenciling on tin. Participants must enroll in Session A or B on both dates to finish their tray. Registration deadline is Dec. 20.

All materials and light refreshments will be provided.

The workshop will be at the Jasper Yeates House Education Center, 24 South Queen Street, one-half block from The Heritage Center Museum.

At this special one-of-a-kind workshop, participants will learn how to bronze-stencil and take home their own finished handcrafted tin tray. The

instructor is nationally-recognized folk artist Linda Brubaker. Cost of the workshop is \$40 per person, or \$35 for

Heritage Center Museum members.
