Starting the day Mikesell selected Nicole Kondziela, Bath, as his champion fitter of the market swine show from the senior divi-

Sarah Blackadar continued to gather the honors as she was named the champion showman of the market lamb show and had her entry named the reserve grand champion market lamb.

Brother Christopher Blackadar was awarded the champion fitter of the market lamb competition and saw his entry receive the grand champion market lamb title as well as placing first in the market lamb pairs division.

Reserve fitter honors of the market lamb show went to James Ford with the reserve showman title going to Amber Buttner.
