I would like to know something about these beautifully carved wood plaques with paintings of peasant women in the center. They hang from hooks on a carved piece of wood. I thought they might be Russian. Any information you could give would be appreciated.

Your carved lacquer pieces depicting a celebration of the harvest are similar to those done by Russian artists. They are still being made. Your example appears to have been made from the 1960s to currently.

I would like the names of collectors of older dolls. I have an Armand Marseille and a "flirty eye" boy doll I would like to sell.

If you have an idea of your asking price, I would suggest you advertise in your local paper, or in one of the many antiques trade publications listed in library reference departs. Since your doll makers are wellknown you can get an idea of their worth in any of the antiques price guides in libraries and book stores.

This photo of a roof tile in the form of a horse, is supposedly from the Ming Dynasty (16th-17th century), given to me by my late grandmother, an antiques dealer. I would like to know the value for selling purposes. I have sent

pictures to different dealers but none responded.

Surprisingly roof tiles from the Ming Dynasty do come to auctions. They have sold for \$4,000-\$6,000.

I have had this floral painted china vase for a long time. It is marked T & V Limoges France. The artist's signature is Ola Redin. It is 16 inches tall.

L.P. -Fruitland Park, FL

Hand-painting of porcelain was popular from the late 19th century to the 1920s. The artists used blanks from many manufacturers including Limoges. The value depends on the quality of the art work. Your handsome piece could sell for \$200 or more in a shop.

Can you tell me the history and evaluate this plate (one of a pair)? One has the portrait of a king; the other a queen. The back says "Carlsbad, Austria."


D.A. - Staten Island, NY

Your portrait plates, made in the early 20th century, could sell in a shop for \$350 a pair.

Can you give me the origin and value of this chair, bought at auction in the 1950s. Supposedly from an old hotel. A whole bedroom set comes with it.

P.A. - Natrona Hgts, PA

Your heavily carved, pierced wood frame chair is a copy of early "Dante," Italian Renaissance style, also known as X-form. This "Renaissance Revival style" 1870s in America. It was also popular in the early 1900s. Similar chairs have sold at auction for \$2,000 or more.
