Dark meat cuts were at least sufficient. Wings were moving into a better balanced position. Retail and distributive draw was limited. The market tone was fully steady to instances firm on wings, barely steady to weak on bone-in breasts, and about steady on the balance.

Prices paid to producers in New England were one cent higher on extra large, large, and medium eggs. Prices were unchanged on the balance of sizes and in other locations. The market tone was generally steady. Demand into all channels was light to moderate. Supplies were adequate to fully adequate for immediate trade needs. Breaking stock offerings were usually sufficient for the light demand. Light type hens were at least adequate for slaughter schedules.

Movement of ready-to-cook whole birds was moderate and clearing the market at a reasonable rate. Demand was moderate with buyer interest and trading. Live supplies was moderate for the market being reported with an estimated slaughter of 1,204,000 compared to 1,294,000 last Tuesday. Weights were desirable. Processing schedules were moderate. Actual slaughter for the week of 11/4-11/8/02 was 6,474,973 head with an average weight of 5.04. Supply of breast are heavy and above average while demand is moderate for the market being reported.

Negotiated F.O.B. dock prices, 2 pounds and heavier ice-packed broilers and fryers, trucklot sales of US Grade A or equivalent were steady at .42-.57 per pound; less than trucklot sales .46-.65 per pound.
