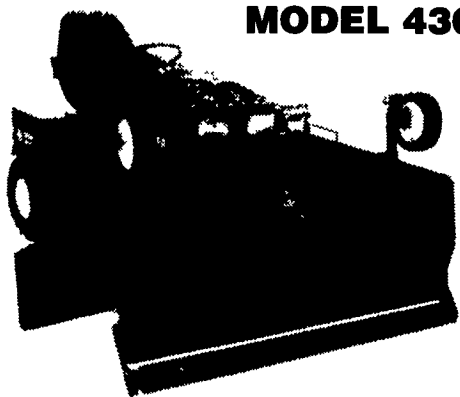

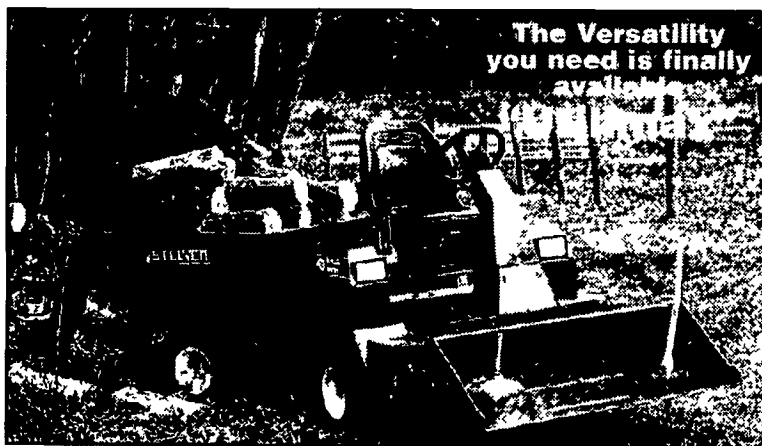

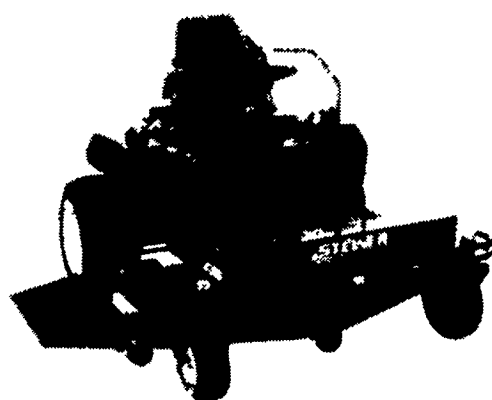


FRONT MOUNTED DECKS Flip Up For Maint. 4'-5'-6'

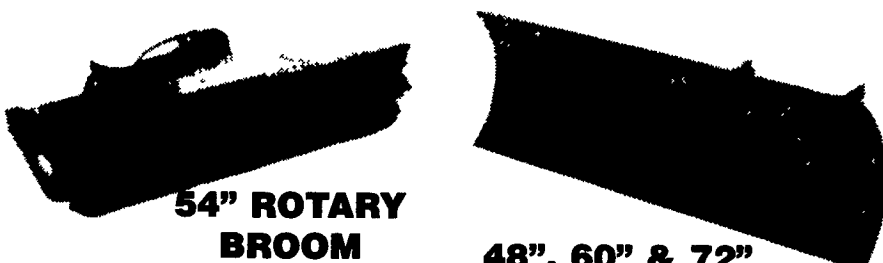

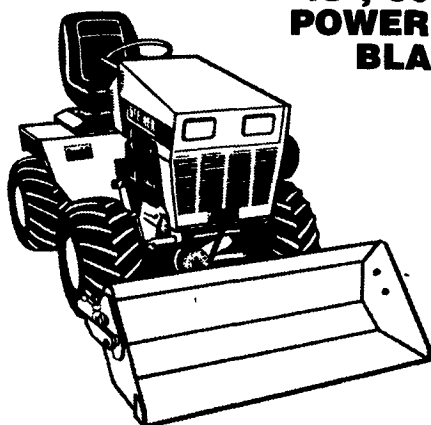

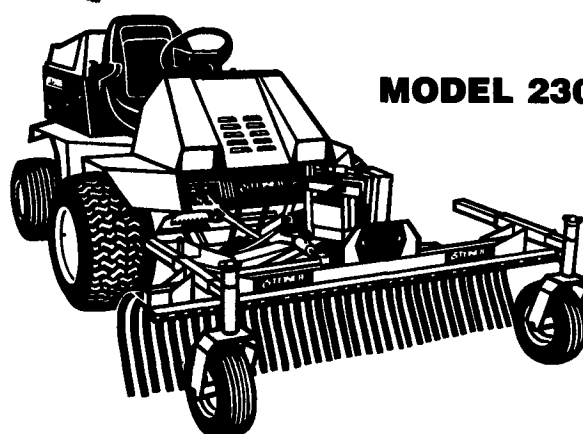

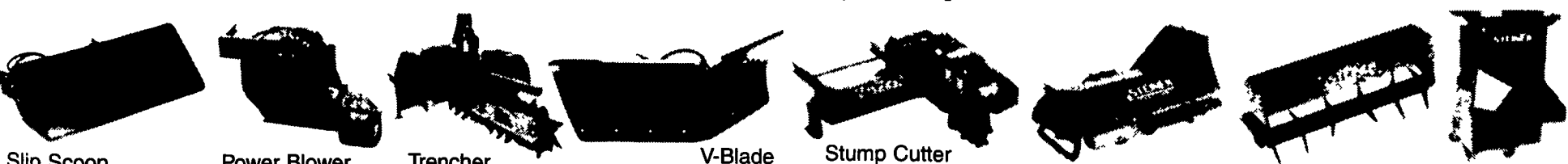
