Buyer activity was only moderate on the bulk of the run, and relatively void on the 220-270 pounders that were bringing from 29.00-31.50 last week. However, with the Western terminal markets trading their 220-270 lb hogs from 26.00-27.00; the local trade still carries a premium. Also, one must remember that the Thanksgiving holiday is only a couple of weeks away; which traditionally slows the pork trade down a little, as most families are not planning on sitting down to pork chops.

Last week the 30-35 pounders were trading from 40.00-80.00, with this week's supply bringing from 135.00-150.00 as the holiday demand has definitely kicked in. All pigs were weighed and graded on arrival and sold by the hundred weights.




