CFS Has New Beginning

CARLISLE (Cumberland Co.) — The CFS organization, consisting of Chambersburg Farm Service and Carlisle Farm Service, began a new era of operation Nov. 1.

CFS was organized by a group of farmers in Franklin County more than 30 years ago. The fundamental principal for founding the business was to assure themselves and fellow farmers that there would be a local dealership to provide quality parts and service for their equipment. Over time, the organization grew to have more than 50 employees and more than 60 shareholders.

Throughout the '70s, '80s, and '90s, CFS did well, achieving local, regional and national recognition for various achievements. However, in October 2001, CFS found itself in a position to seek Chapter 11 bankruptcy protection. Since that time, CFS has operated under the uncertain conditions that 'bankruptcy'' signifies.
