Receipts: 699 Last Week: 690 Last Year: 691. Compared to last Monday, barrows and gilts sold mostly steady; with a few sales trending with a firmer undertone. Bidding was only moderate early, fluctuating throughout the sale as buyers filled their needs. The quality of the run was about average, although when a fancy hog entered the ring bidding increased; which made it apparent buyers are still willing to procure the straight hogs at a premium. However, this is not to say that quality was the deciding factor, as several of the fleshier hogs sold at nearly the same prices as the lean supply. The Western terminal markets are trading hogs from 27.00-29.00 to begin the week; therefore, the local trade is pretty much in line with the rest of the world.
