Smith, Theunis Headline Stakeholders Conference

HARRISBURG (Dauphin Co.) - Rick Smith, chief executive officer of Dairylea Cooperative, Inc., and Carl Theunis, CEO of Tinedale Farm LLP in Wisconsin, will present at the 2002 Pennsylvania Dairy Stakeholders Conference at the Holiday Inn East in Harrisburg Dec. 11-12.

Eleven other presenters, including dairy producers, processors, retailers and dairy market innovators, will join Smith and Tinedale to address the opportunities and responsibilities that will define the future of the

Northeast dairy industry.
Smith has been the CEO of Dairylea, based in Syracuse, since 1988 and has represented the more than 2,500 dairy farmers throughout the Northeast who are members of Dairylea.
